





The Mouse Mansion - The Circus




For this book a whole new fun fair was created, including a haunted house and a rollercoaster, which can all be admired in The Mouse Mansion shop in Amsterdam.



The boat seems to work fine, but then something goes wrong. But Julia doesn't ever give up and Sam can find a solution for any problem. But will they still be able to win the race...?










